EKU's NHS Test and Trace Privacy Policy - COVID 19

Last updated: 23 June 2021

In this Privacy Policy, terms such as "we", "us", "our" or similar expressions shall mean The England Kabaddi Union Ltd. (EKU) and any use of the words "you", "yours" or similar expressions shall mean anyone attending any event organised by EKU.

This Privacy Policy is to be read in addition to the existing documentation available at www.englishkabaddi.com/legal, specifically the general privacy policy available at <https://www.englishkabaddi.com/privacy-policy>.

While the NHS Test and Trace program is in place, we may collect the following information from you:

- Your name;
- Your contact phone number. If a phone number is not available, your email address would be required. If neither are available, then your postal address would be collected;
- Date of visit, arrival time and, where possible, departure time.

We may also record the name of the assisting staff member against your name.

You would not need to provide this data if you scan the NHS Test and Trace QR code. Admission may be denied to you if you do not provide your information and do not scan the NHS Test and Trace QR Code.

We may collect this information in advance and / or upon your arrival to the event. We may work with the facilities management at the event in order to implement NHS Test and Trace data collection.

The information collected for the purposes of NHS Test and Trace will only be used for purposes set out by the government and NHS. The data will also be disposed of in accordance with the government / NHS rules relating to Test and Trace.
