Terms and Conditions

England Kabaddi Union Tournament - 11 July 2021

1. Team member(s) and individuals are voluntarily participating in the said Tournament being organised by the England Kabaddi Union (EKU).
2. Team member(s) and individuals understand and are aware of all the risks, including the risk of contracting COVID-19, associated with attending and taking part in the Tournament.
3. EKU will not be responsible or liable for any damage, health problems or any other issues arising out of the attendance of any individual or team member at the Tournament.
4. Team member(s) and/or individuals shall not hold EKU responsible or liable for any damage or health problems arising out of my attendance at the Tournament.
5. Team member(s) and/or individuals will take the necessary precautions such as wearing face coverings and maintaining social distancing, as prescribed by the EKU and the government, in order to reduce the risk of contracting and spreading COVID-19.
6. Team member(s) and/or individuals understand that players, referees and other people present at the Tournament might not be wearing masks / face coverings while playing.
7. Team member(s) and/or individuals undertake to cooperate with the EKU in following their guidance and rules, providing any form of identification or documentation and following any symptom or medical checks in place for the tournament.
8. Team member(s) and individuals undertake to inform EKU of any COVID-19 symptoms that are experienced by them, as soon as reasonably practicable, based on which they may be denied admission to the tournament.
9. EKU has the right to deny admission to any individual or team member(s), for reasons including, but not limited to non-payment of fees, non-compliance with rules / guidance and/or non-cooperation with EKU officials or representatives.
10. Team member(s) and individuals understand that the tournament may be postponed and/or cancelled at extremely short notice, especially due to COVID-19.
11. In case of cancellation, EKU will try to process refunds for cancellation of the tournament or for anyone being denied admission, as far as reasonably practicable. However, team member(s) and individuals understand that refunds might not be possible, and may depend on the venue's cancellation / refund policy.
12. In case of team sign-ups, the individual submitting the signup form hereby undertakes that he/she is duly authorised by the team and its members to submit the form on their behalf.
