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Eligibility Criteria to represent England

01 August 2024

A player needs to fulfill the following criteria in order to be able to play Kabaddi (Rectangle) for England:

1. The player is a citizen of one of the countries in the United Kingdom.
2. The player holds a valid British passport.
3. The player must not have represented any other country, in any international match or tournament, in the sport of Kabaddi (Rectangle).

Important: Any player who represents England for any federation apart from the England Kabaddi Union (EKU) in any international Kabaddi (Rectangle) match or tournament, from 01 August 2024 onwards, will be deemed **ineligible** to represent England on behalf of the England Kabaddi Union. The decision to allow a player to represent England in the sport of Kabaddi shall rest with The England Kabaddi Union Ltd.

The above criteria will remain in effect until further notice. We will update the eligibility criteria, from time to time and as and when required, and publish it on our website www.Englandkabaddi.com.
