Eligibility criteria update for representing England for ECU

30 June 2024

With effect from **01 August 2024**, any player **who represents England for any federation apart from the England Kabaddi Union (EKU)** in any international Kabaddi (Rectangle) match or tournament will be **deemed ineligible to represent England on behalf of the England Kabaddi Union**.

This decision has been taken after considerable thought. It has been taken to maintain the sanctity of our national representation, our relationships with our affiliate organisations and also to ensure that all players representing England are aligned with the regulations and standards set forth by the ECU.

### Key Points:

- **Exclusivity of representation:** Players must exclusively represent England under the umbrella of the England Kabaddi Union for all international Kabaddi (Rectangle) matches and tournaments.
- **Ineligibility clause:** Any participation in international Kabaddi (Rectangle) matches or tournaments for another federation, apart from the ECU, after 01 August 2024, will result in the player's ineligibility to represent England through the ECU.
- **Enforcement:** This policy is effective from 01 August 2024, and applies to all future international Kabaddi (Rectangle) matches and tournaments.
